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# 10 Questions You Need to Ask

## —before choosing who will do your incorporation and 501(c)(3) application for the IRS

You've never done this before, right? It's your first time, and you feel a bit overwhelmed. It's OK. It's not your fault. Almost all our clients have been right where you are, and today they are moving ahead with their nonprofit organizations. They did it, and with our help, you can do it, too.
